

20MPH REQUEST

Request to make Upper Farringdon a 20mph area

Denise Maughan Farringdon Parish Council Upper Farringdon currently has a 30mph speed limit. It is used by residents, visitors to the pub and church, couriers, Farm vehicles, HGVs, delivery drivers, school bus to name some. It is also used as a cut through to Selborne (and the A3). There are 4 streets which have NO pavement: The Street, Hall Lane, Crows Lane and Gaston Lane. These lanes have blind corners and narrow areas. Church Road is the only road in Upper Farringdon to have a pavement, but this covers less than half the actual road length () Upper Farringdon is used by lots of walkers, horse riders, cyclists and families (often with dogs and young children) who use these roads, as there is no alternative, it is dangerous given the speed limit of 30 mph. We also have no street lighting, which makes it even more dangerous when it is dark, especially in Winter when darkness falls much earlier.

We would ask for your help in applying for Upper Farringdon to be made into a 20mph on road safety grounds.
